**Description:** Grants ranging from \$100 to \$2,500 for USA teachers, churches, and civic clubs for outstanding classroom projects and community initiatives. Funding for teachers is intended to promote worthwhile classroom projects that improve teachers' ability to teach and students' opportunity to learn, and for which funds may not be readily available elsewhere. Funding for community projects is intended for a range of activities that benefit local residents, from playground renewal to cultural endeavors.

**Estimated Size of Grant:** Community and Classroom Grants range from \$100 to \$2,500.

### Eligibility:

### Additional Eligibility Criteria:

Any teacher who is nominated by a FACT member is eligible to apply for a Classroom Grant.

Almost any church, civic club or community project will be seriously considered for a Community Grant if it will benefit some or all of the applicant's neighbors.

**Pre-Application Information:** Applications are reviewed, and grants awarded, quarterly.
