Description: Grants to USA, Canada, and International artists impacted by the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Funding is intended for artists, musicians, and performers who have lost income due to the health crisis. Funding is also intended to offer relief to artists in the immediate short term in the form of a one-time stipend and in the long term in the form of resources for alternative, sustainable economic opportunities.

Full Description:

Estimated Size of Grant: Funds raised will offer relief to artists in two ways: (1) in the short term in the form of a \$200 emergency relief stipend and (2) in the longer term in the form of programs, resources, and support for alternative, sustainable economic opportunities.

Eligibility:

Additional Eligibility Criteria:

Any artist in any discipline who has been impacted by COVID19-related cancellations and closures may apply for assistance. Stipends and support will be given on a first-come, first-serve basis.

The Artist Relief Project will distribute stipends and support every other week on an ongoing, first-come, first-serve basis as long as funding continues. The first round of payouts is anticipated to be distributed around April 23rd, and the number of recipients depends on how much funding is available each distribution cycle. It is accepting donations for the initiative indefinitely and hope to help as many artists as possible during these difficult and uncertain times.

Each distribution cycle, the Artist Relief Project will announce how much funding has been released and send out a courtesy email to recipients. Funds will be transferred to recipients' Paypal accounts or mailed via paper check.
